

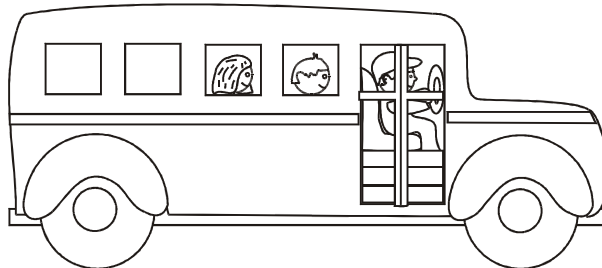
🍎 We're Going On A Field Trip 🍎

Dear Grade 6 Parents,

We are planning a trip to the **National Art Gallery on Friday December 3 2010**. We will be taking a tour while we are there: **Learning to Look or Myths and Other Stories** - Scheduled for 10:15. It lasts approximately 90 minutes. Afterwards we will visit the museum's permanent collection and eat lunch before heading back to the school.

Myths and Other Stories - Historical, biblical and mythological figures are popular subjects for artists throughout the ages and across different cultures. Students discover how artists depict the essential elements of a story. Students' attention will be drawn to the composition, the artist's use of dramatic light or colour, and the facial expressions and gestures of the figures, in order to interpret the meaning of the paintings and sculptures.

Learning to Look - This visit develops students' visual literacy, thinking and reasoning skills. Students learn how to interpret artworks by focusing on composition, the elements and principles of design, and the body language and facial expressions of depicted figures. We will leave school at 9:15 and return at around 2:00.
